Archdiocese of St. Louis Names New Chief Financial Officer

The Archdiocese of St. Louis is pleased to announce that Mr. Cory Nardoni has been named Chief Financial Officer of the organization, effective today, April 13, 2020. Mr. Nardoni replaces Interim CFO Deacon C. Frank Chauvin, and is responsible for managing the departments of finance, accounting, internal audit, information technology, buildings and real estate, shared accounting, and purchasing. As a senior member of the executive team, he reports directly to Archbishop Robert J. Carlson.

Mr. Nardoni most recently served as Chief Financial Officer of Shapiro Metals, a national metals recycler headquartered in Olivette, Mo. He brings diverse experience in public accounting, corporate accounting, finance and management to his role through a work history that includes positions with Deloitte, Rawlings Sporting Goods and Thermadyne Holdings Corporation.

Mr. Nardoni earned both a Bachelor of Science degree in Accounting and a Master's degree in Business Administration (MBA) from Missouri State University in Springfield, Mo. He is a licensed Certified Public Accountant (CPA).

The Archdiocese of St. Louis is grateful to Deacon C. Frank Chauvin for serving as Interim CFO during the search process. Returning to the CFO position on an interim basis is just one of his many significant contributions during his tenure with the archdiocese.

In accepting the position of CFO, Mr. Nardoni stated that he and his family "are humbled and elated to be joining the team at the archdiocese," and that he looks forward to serving the Catholic community of St. Louis.

Mr. Nardoni, his wife, Marisa, and their family are parishioners of St. Clare of Assisi Parish in Ellisville, Mo., where their son and daughter also attend school. In his free time, Mr. Nardoni volunteers as a CYC and club soccer coach, and as a martial arts instructor.
