- Degreed and certified in the appropriate area for the position desired (early childhood, elementary, specific subject areas, areas of specialty)
- Understanding of, and commitment to, the philosophy of Catholic education
- Knowledge of, and best practice skills in, curriculum development, instructional methodology and assessment of students
- Organizational skills and strategies in the areas of planning, lesson design, time use and classroom management
- Strong interpersonal skills and relational skills, especially in the area of communication

- Grades K – 5 grade level classrooms
- Grades 6 – 8 homerooms and core subject areas (religion, ELA, Math, science, social studies)
