Suggested uses for the beONE prayer:

1. The prayer can be used by the priest celebrant as the Priest's Prayer at the conclusion of the Universal Prayers at all parish Masses.
2. The prayer can be used by the faithful at all parish Masses as a conclusion to the Universal Prayers.
3. The prayer can be used by the faithful at the conclusion of all parish Masses; similar to those parishes that pray a prayer for vocations, Saint Michael Prayer, etc., at the end of Mass.
4. The prayer can be used at the meetings of various parish groups (Parish Council, Finance Council, Liturgy Committee, parish choir, staff and faculty meetings, etc.) and in offices and agencies of the Curia as a way of connecting the work they do with the evangelizing efforts of the Archdiocese of St. Louis.
5. The prayer can be used at the beginning or ending of the school day. Students can keep a copy in their desks or teachers can reproduce a framed copy for their classroom.
6. Parishes may want to place the prayer in their bulletins (as a bulletin cover or in a special place on the bulletin masthead) or may want to reproduce the B1 Prayer on prayer cards and keep them at the entrances to the church.
