"Evangelization is a complex process and entails various elements. Among them missionary animation has always paid special attention to solidarity. This is also one of the objectives of World Mission Day which, through the Pontifical Mission Societies, requests aid in order to carry out the tasks of evangelization in mission territories.

"It is a matter of supporting institutions necessary for establishing and consolidating the Church through catechists, seminaries and priests, and of making one's own contribution to improving the standard of living for people in countries where the phenomena of poverty, malnutrition—especially among children—disease, the lack of health care and education are the most serious. This is also part of the Church's mission and in proclaiming the Gospel, she takes human life to heart fully. May World Mission Day revive in each one the desire to go and the joy of 'going' to meet humanity, bringing Christ to all."
