Our monastery as a Powerhouse of Prayer reaches the Archdiocese and beyond as is testified by the many prayer petitions we receive each day by phone, letter or e-mail. We do the sewing of the capes for the Knights and Ladies of the Holy Sepulchre. Our group of dedicated Lay Associates meets each month for a talk on spirituality to encourage them in their daily journey with the Lord in their families and work places. They try in their own way to carry on the VIVA MEMORIA of Jesus.

Our day is a simple one scheduled with Prayer as our priority. The Mass is the focal point of the day. We come together as a Community five times a day remembering you and your intentions and giving praise and thanksgiving. Each day there is time for personal prayer and spiritual reading. We have devotion to Our Mother of Perpetual Help and each June 19-27 there is a public Novena to which many people come. Every Sister has one or two specific seminarians of the Archdiocese as a Prayer Partner.
